We have a very nice set of bulls in Test #69. Regardless of breed, the consignors should be extremely proud of the bulls they have put on test. The sale will be **Noon, April 7, 2010, at the Mitchell County Fairgrounds in Beloit, KS**. Bulls that are eligible for the sale have been marked with A "YES".

Cattle were scanned for ribeye area, marbling and backfat and that information is enclosed. This year we utilized CUP Ultrasound technology and Ultra Insights, so we are reporting % IMF instead of marbling. The first round of breeding soundness exams have been completed.

All of the bulls have been DNA tested. That data is enclosed with an explanation sheet explaining what the numbers stand for.
